

The social, political, or economic domination of one country over another.



<u>The Context</u>


- End of 18th century colonialism appeared dead
- Britain had lost the American colonies
- Spain and Portugal's power in South America was less than it had been
- Nationalism- belief that a people's loyalty should not be to a king, but to a nation of people that share a common history
 - Leads to development of nation-states, increased competition between states

World in 1800 – 1st wave of imperialism




The Second Wave


- A hundred years later, however, a second wave of colonization took place.
- From 1880-1900 European powers seized control of a dramatic number of countries in Africa and Asia.




1914: Imperialism and the Balance of Power
