Luther's Ideas Spread

- Luther's ideas spread all through Europe
- Protestant ideas took different forms in different places
- Switzerland → Calvinism
- England → Anglicanism



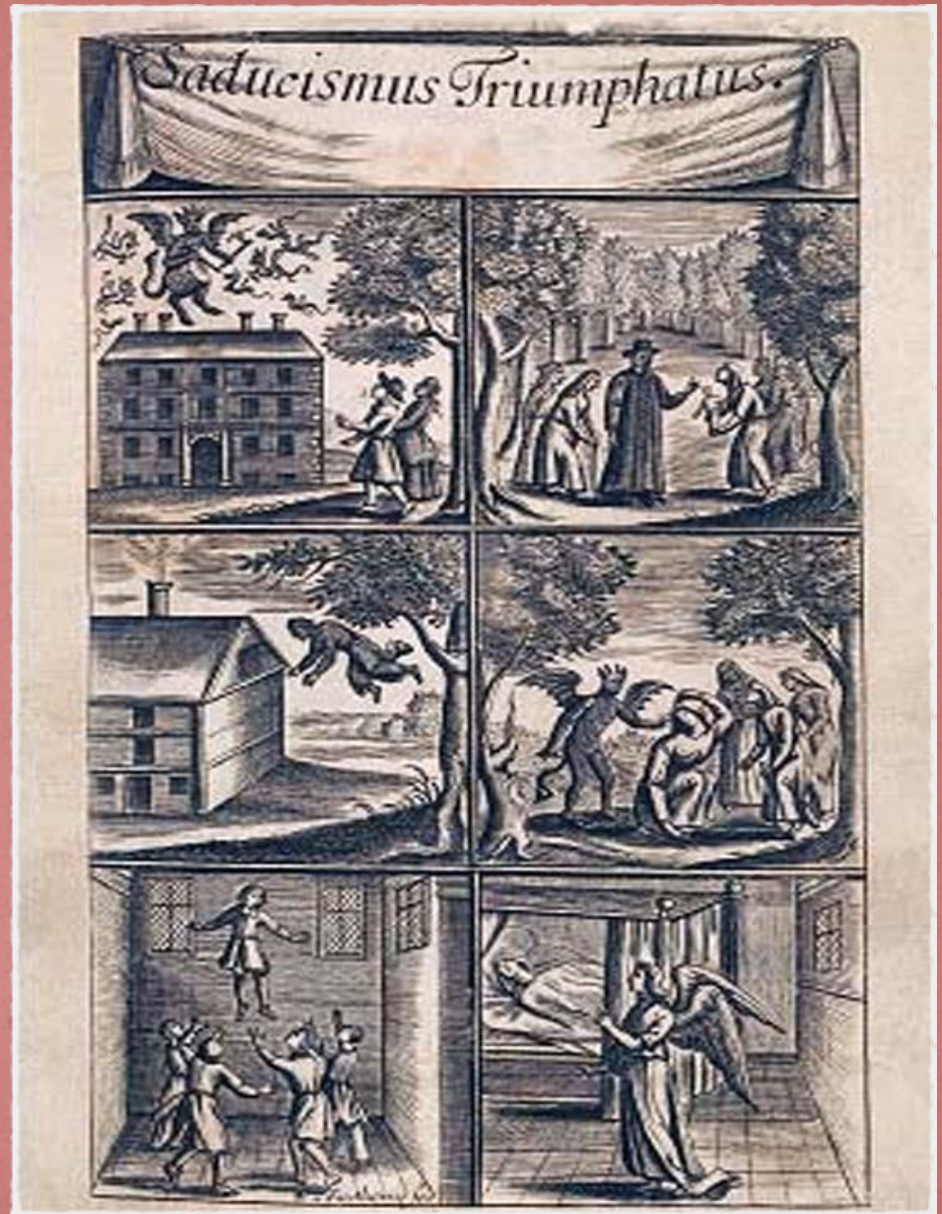
Catholic Counter-Reformation

- Luther had highlighted problems with the Catholic Church
- Church realized they had to make changes
 - To 'fix' problems
 - To regain loyalty of church members
 - To maintain legitimacy as a religious authority
- Counter-reformation was a response to Luther and Protestantism



Persecution

- Many groups faced persecution during this time.
 - Anabaptists and Jews
- Witch Hunts and hysteria throughout the time period
