## Biography: The Negro league Teams

Your assignment is to research one of the Negro Baseball League Teams below individually and create a PowerPoint/Slides presentation about your topic. Make sure your PowerPoint/Slides presentation includes all the required elements and that the PowerPoint is visually appealing, including pictures, and is organized. The project is worth 20 points total. Below is a list of the required elements to include in your poster. Use the [Negro League Hall of Fame eMuseum](#) website to help you with your research.

- **a brief history of the team, including:**
  - **how it began and ended (1-2 paragraphs)**
  - **the team's owner**
  - **the team's best record, including the year**
  - **the team's playoff history**
  - **Image or drawing of the team's logo**
- **a list of three of the team's best players, the years they played, and their positions (2-3 sentences per player & a picture)**
- **a brief description of any of the teams' players inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame**

You will have 3 work days and your project is due Friday, May 8, 2020 via email by 5pm.

A suggested schedule for work would be:

- **Wednesday:** Choose a team and begin research.
- **Thursday:** Finish researching a team. Begin PowerPoint/Slides Presentation
- **Friday:** Finish PowerPoint/Slides Presentation. Edit & Check for all required elements. Email finished PowerPoint/Slides Presentation by 5pm.
