Vocab List: Interwar Years & Russian Revolution

- **1: Proletariat-**Working class made up of factory & railroad workers, miners, & urban workers. This group would lead the communist revolution in Russia.
- **2: Communism-** System of government in which there would be a classless society that shares wealth and property. In theory the government would go away.
- **3: Lenin-**Started and led the communist revolution in Russia. He gained the peoples support by promising them "peace, land, & bread." He increased the standard of living & increased food & industrial production.
- **4: New Economic Policy-** Lenin's successful economic policy that mixed communism and capitalism.
- **5: Bolsheviks-**The name given to Communist supporters during the Russian Civil war.
- **6: Stalin-** Brutal totalitarian leader who took over after Lenin. He killed millions of people and instituted failed agricultural and industrial programs.
- **7: Neutrality Acts-**US policy following WWI that declared that the US would not get involved in the affairs of other nations.
- **8: League of Nations-** International organization that was created after WWI. Its goal was to prevent another world war but discussing problems between nations instead of fighting. They had no real power & no army.
- **9: Inflation-**The rise in the price of goods and services and a decrease in the value of a nation's currency (money)
- **10: Weimar Republic-** Government that was set up in Germany after Germany surrendered in WWI. They signed the Treaty of Versailles and was disliked by most Germans.
